Many of the GEAR courses can fulfill two requirements at once: GE/Major, GE/Minor, GE/DCG, DCG/Major, but never GE/GE. Courses that meet the outcomes of more than completed at HSU one GE area A-F, can only be used for one of those areas.]

### Lower Division GE

Take GE Area A and B: Math before you earn 60 units (or 30 units for transfer students). Pass each with a C- or better.
